

BLOCK OF THE MONTH FOR MARCH 2008

"Hour Glass"

(8" finished - 8½" unfinished)

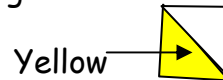
Fabric and Cutting - For 2 blocks

White print/solid	Cut 4 @ 4 7/8" and cut diagonally once
Bright yellow print/solid	Cut 1 @ 4 7/8" and cut diagonally once
Bright pink print/solid	Cut 1 @ 4 7/8" and cut diagonally once
Bright purple print/solid	Cut 1 @ 4 7/8" and cut diagonally once
Bright green print/solid	Cut 1 @ 4 7/8" and cut diagonally once

Block Assembly

Sew together one white triangle to each of the yellow, pink, purple and green triangles to make 4 half-square triangles pressing to the dark side.

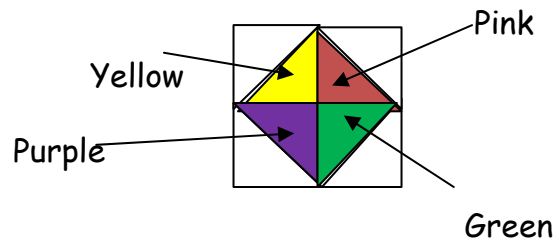
Figure #1



Lay out the 4 half-square triangles (one of each color) in two rows. Sew the pieces together in each row. Press seam allowances to opposite sides.

Join the 2 rows to make the Hourglass block.
