

BLOCK OF THE MONTH FOR MAY 2008

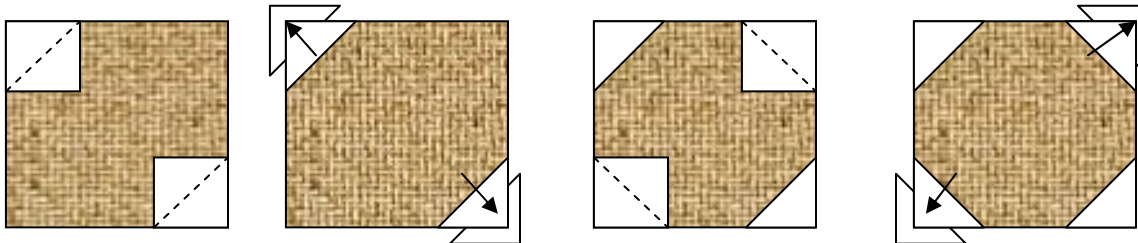
"30's Charmed" (6" finished - 6½" unfinished)

Fabric and cutting (for 1 block)

1. Your choice of **30's reproduction**
2. Cut (1) @ 6 ½" square
3. Your choice of **white** solid/tone on tone
4. Cut (4) @ 2 ½" square

Sewing

Snowball the corners! With right sides together, place a white 2 ½" square on the corner of the 6 ½" 30's print matching edges. Draw a line lightly from corner to corner on the wrong side of the white square as a guide, if needed, and stitch the layered squares together exactly on the drawn lines. Repeat for each corner.



Press the seam open and then trim the bottom two layers. Note: After "snowballing" the corner, you can sew a second seam parallel to the 1st one - be sure to leave enough space for two seam allowances. When you trim the bottom two layers you will have an extra ½ square triangle which can be squared up and used in another project - maybe a miniature pinwheel!

Everyone will receive a "ticket" for each block turned in. This will allow you a chance to win a nice collection of "quilt blocks".
