

## BLOCK OF THE MONTH FOR NOVEMBER 2008

### "Churn Dash for Kids"

9" finished - 9 ½" unfinished

\*\*Please use good quality 100% cotton fabrics. Use fabrics suitable for small children.

White or light solid/tone on tone:

4A Cut 2 at 3 7/8" square and cut diagonally once.

1B Cut 1 at 3 ½" square.

4C Cut 4 at 2" x 3 ½".

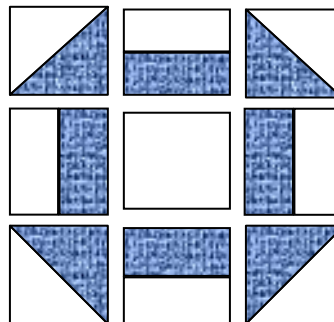
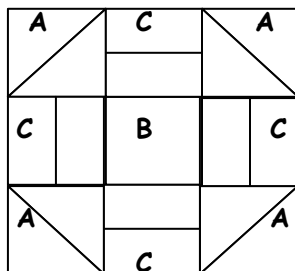
Bright prints:

4A Cut 2 at 3 7/8" square and cut diagonally once.

4C Cut 4 at 2" x 3 ½".

Sewing:

Use your favorite method of making half-square triangles for the corner units. A suggestion would be to cut two 4" squares of fabric (one light, one bright), place the right sides together, draw a line lightly on the diagonal. Stitch ¼" each side of the drawn line, cut apart, press to the dark side. Square up to 3 ½".



Make 1-5 blocks. You will receive a ticket for each block turned in for a chance to win a nice collection of quilt blocks. Each month, the 1<sup>st</sup> five people to bring in 5 blocks will win a special prize.
