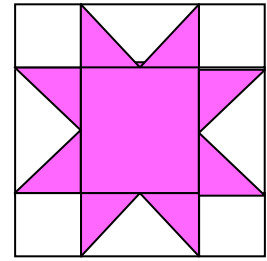


APRIL 2009 BLOCK OF THE MONTH

ORANGE COUNTY SUNRISE!

Saw Tooth stars created with a colorful mix of prints set in a light background remind us of the wonderful colors given to us by an early morning's inspiring sunrise.



Directions:

- ♥ Use good quality pre-washed 100 % cotton fabrics.
- ♥ Unfinished block is $8 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
- ♥ Great quilt design available using these squares.

Fabric colors:

- ♥ Yellow, gold, light orange, dark orange, pink, or coral prints for stars.
- ♥ Light tan print for background.

Cutting Instructions for 1 block:

For Stars:

- 8 ($2 \frac{1}{2}$ ") squares
- 1 ($4 \frac{1}{2}$ ") square

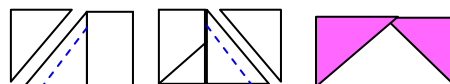


DIAGRAM 1

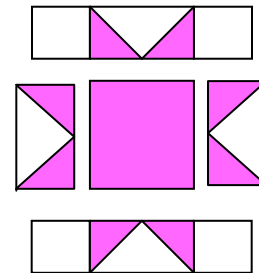


DIAGRAM 2

For Background:

- 4 ($2 \frac{1}{2}$ " by $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ") rectangles
- 4 ($2 \frac{1}{2}$ " by $2 \frac{1}{2}$ ") squares

Sewing Directions:

1. Use a pencil to mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each star $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " square.
2. Align a marked square with one end of a tan background $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " by $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, right sides together. Note the direction of drawn line in [Diagram 1](#).
3. Sew on drawn line. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press open attached triangle.
4. Repeat on other side forming a Flying Geese unit.
5. Repeat to make 4 units.
6. Referring to [Diagram 2](#), sew together the Flying Geese units, and the remaining pieces. Press seams away from Flying Geese units. When sewing to $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " square, press seams toward center.



Make as many blocks as you want! Use up that stash fabric! You will receive a ticket for each block turned in for a chance to win a nice collection of blocks.
