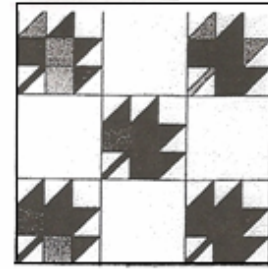


MAPLE LEAVES



The 3rd of our new 2009-2010 "Calendar Quilt Blocks" will bring autumn inside for you to enjoy all year long in a block that features scrappy maple leaves!

Directions:

Use good quality pre-washed 100% cotton fabrics
The finished block will be 9" square

Fabric:

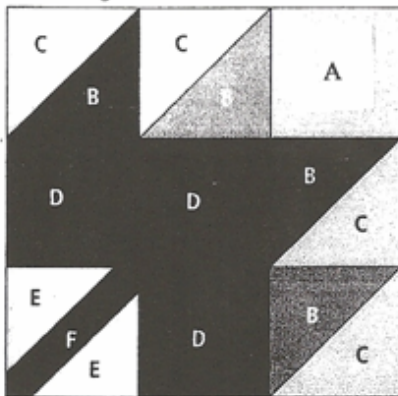
Background: Cream, light beige: tone-on-tone
Maple Leaves: Fall colors (orange, rust, gold, yellow, green, etc.). Tone-on tone, batiks, small, medium print. Mix up colors for a more interesting leaf.

Cutting Directions: Refer to Block Diagram and cut pieces listed.

Sewing Directions:

- Sew 4 half-square triangle units (B/C), right sides together, for each block. Press seam toward the B triangle.

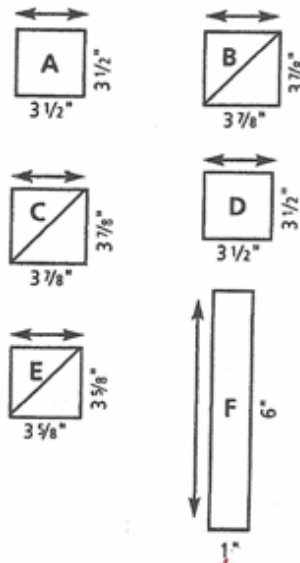


Fig. 1 Sew E triangle to F stem strip as shown.

- To make the stem square sew an E triangle to each side of the F stem strip. Press the seams toward the stem strip. Trim the unit to 3 1/2" square. (Fig. 1).

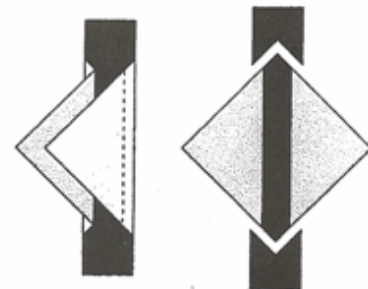
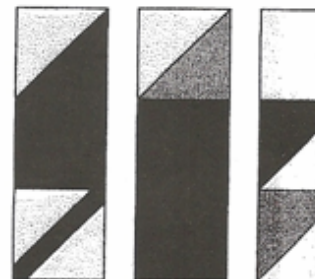


Fig. 2 Arrange squares into blocks.

- Arrange the squares into a block. Sew the squares into rows. Join the rows. (Fig. 2). Press seams of alternate rows in opposite directions.

Block Diagram



Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.
Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.
