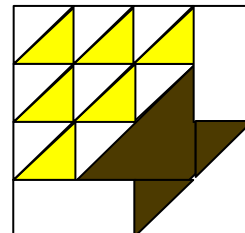


MAY 2010 BLOCK OF THE MONTH FLOWER BASKET



Fabrics:

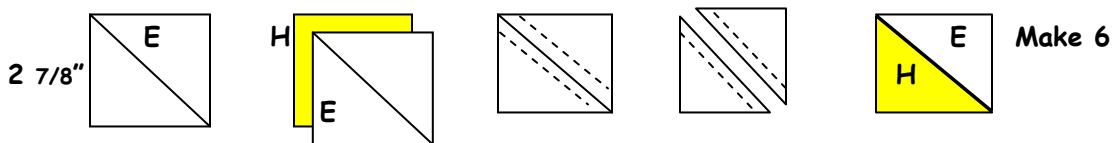
- ★ Use good quality, 100% cotton, pre-washed fabrics.
- ★ The finished block will be 8 inches.
- ★ We will use "spring colors" fabrics for the flowers, brown for the basket
And the background can be white or white on white.

Cutting Instructions:

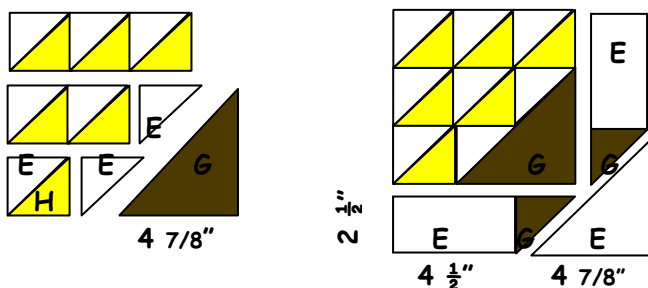
- ★ Flower Body - Bright Spring Colors, may all be the same or mixed (**H**):
Cut 3 squares, 3"x3".
- ★ Brown Basket (**G**):
Cut one 4 7/8" square, cut in half diagonally, making 2 triangles
(you will use only one).
Cut one 2 7/8" square, cut in half diagonally to make 2 triangles.
- ★ Background - White or White on White (**E**):
Cut three 3"x3" squares.
Cut two 2 1/2"x4 1/2" rectangles.
Cut one 2 7/8"x 2 7/8" square, cut in half diagonally, to make 2 triangles.
Cut one 4 7/8"x4 7/8" square, cut in half diagonally, making 2 triangles
(you will use only one).

Sewing Instructions:

- ★ Make 6 half square triangle units using the Flower/Background fabric. Draw a diagonal line on the backside of the 3 (**E**) squares, pair one (**E**) and one (**H**) square right sides together. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the line. Separate units by cutting on the line, press to the dark. Square to 2 1/2". Repeat for 6 units.



- ★ Sew block together in rows according to diagram.
