Unfinished Block Size: 8 1/2"

Finished Block Size: 8"

Background fabric: Black

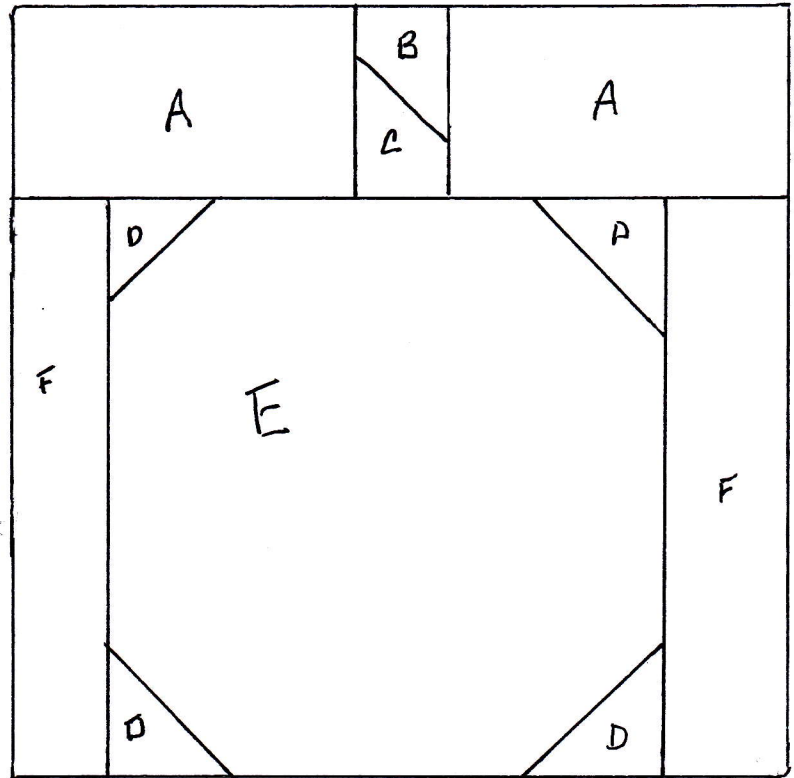
- Cut 2 – 2 1/2" x 4" rectangles (A)
- Cut 1 – 1 1/2" x 2" rectangle (B)
- Cut 4 – 1 1/2" squares (D)
- Cut 2 – 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (F)

Stem: Green fabric,

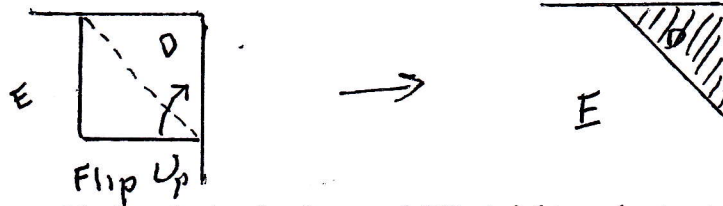
Cut 1 – 1 1/2" x 2" rectangle (C)

Pumpkin: Orange fabric

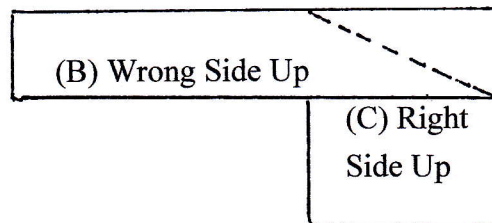
Cut 1 – 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square (E)



1. Snowball 1 1/2" square (D) to corners of pumpkin center (E)



2. Make stem assembly by placing background (B) at right angles to stem (C), matching one end of the pieces, and right sides together. Sew diagonally across the end:



3. Assemble by joining pieces A to stem assembly above and pieces F to sides of pumpkin. Finally join stem and pumpkin assemblies.
