CLASS DESCRIPTION

Come learn all about how I hand appliqué and layer multi pieced patterns while working on a small wall hanging featuring four 7" square cat portraits. You can choose to work on one of the cats, I will show you how to change the basic pattern to look like your own cat, or you can bring your favorite fabric to use in the pattern and make a fantasy cat. Later in the class I will also demonstrate how to make a pattern of your cat (or other pet) from a photograph.

CAT FACES SUPPLY LIST:

- ♥ Fabric Scissors (Any sharp scissors with a pointed tip. I like the 5" embroidery scissors).
 - ♥ Paper Scissors.
 - ♥ Freezer Paper (I will bring some to share to use for templates).
 - ♥ Straight Pins.

- ♥ Pencil sharpener.
 - ♥ Needles: no. 10 or 11 Sharps (I like the English Brands like Richard Hemming).
 - ♥ Thread to match fabric (50 or 60 weight cotton or polyester or silk are all fine).
 - ♥ Marking pencils:
 1. For dark fabrics: Quilter's Rule or Roxanne's white or your choice.
 2. For light fabrics: Silver pencil or Blue Washout or your choice.
 - ♥ Fabric (Prewash all fabrics. Prints or solids- I like prints).
 - ♥ Background: $\frac{1}{2}$ -yard blue or background color of your choice.
 - ♥ For the cats in the patterns, small pieces (1/8 yard) of the following colors: Black, white, light grey, brown, tan, black/grey stripes, orange or orange stripes (a variety of each color will make the cat more interesting). In the black and white cat I used five black prints).
 - ♥ Small scraps of blue, yellow, and green for the eyes.
 - ♥ If you choose to make your own cat bring colors that look like your cat. Prints work well and they do not have to exactly look like fur. Stripes, checks, florals will work if they are in your cat's colors. If your cat is all one color bring a variety (lights and darks) of that color.
 - ♥ Also bring photos of your cat.
